PERMIT PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, this permit is granted to allow performance of the specific work described herein. The following standard provisions and any included special provisions shall govern:

(1) The Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the village, its employees and its agents, from any cost, claim, suit, liability and/or award which might come, be brought, or be assessed, because of the issuance or exercise of this permit, or because of any adverse effect upon any person or property may be attributed to the partially or entirely completed works of the Applicant. Accomplishment of the permitted work, or any part thereof, by or on behalf of the Applicant shall bind such Applicant to abide by this permit and all its conditions and provisions. This indemnification is intended to be to the fullest extent allowed by law and shall include all costs of defense, including attorney's fees.

(2) The permitted facilities shall, if deemed necessary by the applicant, be altered at the expense of the Applicant to permit alteration, improvement, or maintenance of the highway as may hereafter be ordered. Any such alteration shall be subject to the prior review, consultation, and approval of the Village. The entire cost of constructing and maintaining the permitted facilities shall be the obligation of the Applicant unless a contract for such costs has been executed.

(3) No open cutting for a crossing will be allowed where the pavement is too narrow to maintain one way traffic at all times, unless the Permitting Authority has granted permission for a detour. Wherever the pavement is opened, the spoil shall be hauled away. Trenching, backfilling and pavement replacement shall be in accordance with Village standards and specifications and shall be subject to Village inspection and prior approval.

(4) When one-way traffic or a detour is used, the Applicant shall provide ALL NECESSARY SIGNS, FLAGMEN AND LIGHTS and follow all procedures required by the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" of the Federal Highway Administration and the State of Wisconsin. When a detour is allowed, local news media shall be notified by the Applicant at least one week in advance of the work being started.

(5) All disturbed areas shall be returned to their present condition or better, subject to the satisfaction of the Permitting Authority or its representative. Access to all private drives and public street intersections shall be maintained, and all disturbed areas completely restored.

(6) Any trenching, tunneling, or excavating shall be performed in accordance with the requirements of OSHA and any applicable state and local regulations.

(7) A copy of this approval, along with any plans and special provisions, shall be available on the job site.

(8) Upon completion of the work the Applicant shall file a written notice with the Permitting Authority.
